PROFILE OF THE CLASS OF 2002

- 353 students selected from 3,368 applicants from 522 colleges and universities
- 194 non-resident students from 41 states, Puerto Rico, and the District of Columbia
- 178 men, 175 women
- 50 minority students among the 287 who identified their ethnicity
- median GPA: 3.7 on a 4.0 scale
- median LSAT: 165
- average age: 24

Although widely differing approaches to college grading often serve to render comparative statements about undergraduate records misleading, it is significant that most of the students in the Class of 2002 ranked in the upper 20 percent of their graduating classes. Many of these students also completed advanced degree work.
