I. INTRODUCTION

- 1. In paragraph 1 of resolution 32/64 of 8 December 1977, the General Assembly called upon all Nember States to reinforce their support of the Declaration on the Protection of All Persons from Being Subjected to Torture and Other Cruel, Inhuman or Degrading Treatment or Punishment by making unilateral declarations against torture and other cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment, along the lines of a model unilateral declaration annexed to the said resolution, and depositing them with the Secretary-Ceneral.
- 2. In paragraph 2 of the same resolution, the General Assembly also urged all Member States to give maximum publicity to their unilateral declarations against torture and other cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment. In paragraph 3, the Secretary-General was requested to inform the General Assembly, in annual reports, of such unilateral declarations as might be deposited by Member States.
- 3. In conformity with paragraph 3 of resolution 32/64, this report reproduces the unilateral declarations received, as of 1 October 1973, from the following States: Belgium, Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Iran, Italy, Luxembourg, Norway and Syeden.

BELCIUM

- (b) To continue to implement, through legislation and other effective measures, the provisions of the said Declaration.
