### SINEGAL

The Government of Schegal declares its intention, pursuant to General Assembly resolution 33/178 of 20 December 1978 concerning torture and other cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment:

- (a) To abide by the Declaration on the Protection of All Persons from Being Subjected to Torture and Other Cruel, Inhuman or Degrading Treatment or Punishment (resolution 3452 (XXX) of the General Assembly);
- (b) To apply the provisions of that resolution by means of legislation or other effective measures.

## DEMOCRATIC YEMEN

<u>/Original: Arabi</u> /25 June 197<u>9</u>/

- 1. The Government of the People's Democratic Republic of Yemen officially declares its intention to adhere to the Declaration on the Protection of All Persons from Being Subjected to Torture and Other Cruel, Inhuman or Degrading Treatment or Punishment, annexed to resolution 3452 (XXX) adopted by the Gene Assembly on 9 December 1975, and to continue, by all appropriate means, to purinto practice principles affirmed in the Declaration.
- In this connexion, the Government of the People's Democratic Republic o Yenen points out that its legislation is in conformity with the provisions of Declaration.
