YUGOSLAVIA

[Original: Fnglish] [22 October 1979]

- 1. The Government of the Socialist Federal Pepublic of Yusoslavia hereby expresses its readiness to consistently comply with the Declaration on the Protection of All Persons from Being Subjected to Torture and Other Cruel Inhuman or Degrading Treatment or Punishment (General Assembly resolution 3452 (YCV), annex).
- 2. It declares, at the same time, that, on the basis of the Constitution of the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, the Federal Criminal Law and the Law on Criminal Frocedure and the laws of the Republics relating to the enforcement of criminal sanctions, strict compliance with the provisions of the said declaration has been assured.
