Letter dated 2 January 1984 from Mr. Rauf R. Denktas to the Secretary-General

IN MY LETTER ADDRESSED TO YOU ON 15 NOVEMBER 1983 (A/38/586-S/16148) CONCERNING OUR DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE; I HAD EXPRESSED THE TURKISH CYPRIOT SIDE'S EARNEST DESIRE TO FIND A PEACEFUL SOLUTION TO ALL THE DIFFERENCES BETHEEN THE TURKISH AND GREEK CYPRIOT PEOPLES, THROUGH NEGOTIATIONS TO BE HELD UNDER YOUR EXCELLENCY'S GOOD OFFICES, AND STRESSED THE IMPORTANCE OF ''THE TAKING; IN THE SHORT TERM, OF CERTAIN PRACTICAL GOODHILL HEASURES THAT CAN NARROH THE GAP BETHEEN THE THO PEOPLES'', I HAD ALSO INDICATED, IN THE SAME CONTEXT, THAT HE HOULD BE ''GIVING CONCRETE INDICATIONS OF OUR CONSTRUCTIVE APPROACH IN THIS REGARD''.

AS AN INDICATION OF OUR SINCERITY AND GOODNILL IN THIS RESPECT, I HAVE MADE, THIS MORNING, A PUBLIC STATEMENT CONTAINING CONCRETE PROPOSALS TO THE GREEK CYPRIOT SIDE ON FOUR IMPORTANT SUBJECTS, NAMELY VAROSHA, NICOSIA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, THE QUESTION OF MISSING PERSONS AND THE GENERAL FRAMEHORK OF THE RELATIONS BETHEEN THE THO SIDES FOR PROGRESS TOWARDS A FINAL SETTLEMENT, THE TEXT OF WHICH I AM ENCLOSING FOR YOUR EXCELLENCY'S INFORMATION AND EVALUATION.

- I EARNESTLY HOPE THAT YOUR EXCELLENCY HILL URGE THE GREEK CYPRIOT SIDE TO GIVE SERIOUS CONSIDERATION TO THESE CONCRETE PROPOSALS, NITHIN A RECIPROCAL SPIRIT OF GOODWILL AND ACCOMMODATION.
- I SHALL BE GRATEFUL IF THIS COMMUNICATION AND THE ATTACHED TEXT OF MY STATEMENT HERE CIRCULATED AS A DOCUMENT OF THE GENERAL ASSENBY, UNDER AGENDA ITEM 41, AND OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL.

PLEASE ACCEPT: YOUR EXCELLENCY: THE ASSURANCES OF MY HIGHEST CONSIDERATION.

STATEMENT BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE TURKISH REPUBLIC OF NORTHERN CYPRUS; H.E. HR. RAUF R. DENKTAS; CONCERNING THE GOODHILL MEASURES PROPOSED BY THE TURKISH CYPRIOT SIDE

I. THE GENERAL OUTLOOK AND APPROACH OF THE TURKISH CYPRIOT SIDE:

ON 15 NOVEMBER 1983, HE THE TURKISH PEOPLE OF CYPRUS, WHILE EXERCISING OUR RIGHT TO SELF-DETERMINATION FOR CONSTRUCTIVE PURPOSES, EXTENDED OUR HAND TO THE GREEK CYPRIOT PEOPLE IN PEACE AND FRIENDSHIP IN ORDER TO BRING TO AN END, ONCE AND FOR ALL, THE 20-YEAR OLD POLITICAL UNCERTAINTY IN THE ISLAND AND TO REACH A FINAL SOLUTION TO ALL THE PROBLEMS BETWEEN THE TURKISH CYPRIOT PEOPLE AND THE GREEK CYPRIOT PEOPLE. WE LEFT THE DOOR OPEN FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A NEW PARTNERSHIP, HITHIN THE FRAMEHORK OF A FEDERATION BETHEEN THE THO PEOPLES LIVING ON THE ISLAND, AND HE HAVE EXPRESSED OUR GENUINE HISH AND DETERMINATION TO REACH A JUST AND LASTING SOLUTION HITHIN THE SPIRIT OF A CONCILIATORY APPROACH. HE ARE THO PEOPLES DESTINED TO LIVE SIDE BY SIDE ON THIS ISLAND. NO MATTER HON HIDE APART OUR PRESENT POINTS OF VIEW MIGHT BE, THIS FACT CANNOT BE CHANGED EITHER BY US OR BY THE GREEK CYPRIOTS. THE CONTINUED STATE OF TENSION BETHEEN US: AT A TIME WHEN WE SHOULD RATHER BE TRYING TO RESOLVE OUR DIFFERENCES: AND CONTINUING TO BEHAVE IN A MANNER INCITING ENMITY BETHEEN THE THO PEOPLES ARE VERY HARMFUL AND CONSTITUTE AN OBSTACLE TO PROGRESS TOWARDS A FINAL FEDERAL SOLUTION. FOR THIS REASON WE MAINTAIN THAT WE MUST BUILD UP OUR RELATIONS ON A CONSTRUCTIVE BASIS. LET US NORK WITH DETERMINATION TOWARDS A FINAL COMPROMISE AND RECONCILIATION. LET US BIRECT OUR EFFORTS TOWARDS POSITIVE ENDS AND STEADILY PROCEED IN THAT COURSE. LET US ABANDON NEGATIVE ATTITUDES GEARED TOWARDS DESTROYING EACH OTHER. LET US NOT FORGET THAT OTHERS CANNOT TAKE DECISIONS ON BEHALF OF THE TWO PEOPLES OF CYPRUS, AND THAT ONLY THROUGH OUR OWN EFFORTS, TREADING THE SAME PATH TOGETHER AND HELPING EACH OTHER: SHALL HE BE ABLE TO PROCEED TOWARDS A FEDERAL SOLUTION. I, THEREFORE, INVITE THE GREEK CYFRIOT SIDE TO TREAD WITH US THE SAME CONSTRUCTIVE AND PEACEFUL PATH BY PASSING THROUGH THE DOOR HE ARE STILL HOLDING OPEN FOR THEM.

TO-DAY, I SHOULD LIKE TO EXTEND TO THE GREEK CYPRIOTS THE FOLLOWING PROPOSALS OF GOODNILL, SO THAT THE FIRST STEPS COULD BE TAKEN TOWARDS A COMPREHENSIVE SOLUTION OF OUR PROBLEMS. I AM ALSO INFORMING THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE U.N. OF THESE PROPOSALS AND KINDLY REQUESTING HIM TO HELP BOTH SIDES HITHIN THE FRAMEHORK OF HIS MISSION OF GOOD OFFICES, WHICH HE FULLY SUPPORT, SO THAT THESE PROPOSALS COULD BE IMPLEMENTED.

II. TURKISH CYPRIOT PROPOSALS ON VAROSHA:

- 1. THE TURKISH CYPRIOT SIDE REITERATES ITS READINESS TO ENGAGE IN NEGOTIATIONS ON ITS PROPOSALS OF IT NOVEMBER 1983 CONCERNING VAROSHA AND THE NICOSIA INTERNATIONAL AIRFORT HITH THE GREEK CYPRIOT SIDE. HOLDING OF NEGOTIATIONS ON THESE ISSUES HILL BE HITHOUT PREJUDICE TO THE RESPECTIVE POSITIONS OF THE THO SIDES HITH REGARD TO EACH OTHER'S POLITICAL STATUS.
- 2. VAROSHA AND THE NICOSIA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT ARE THO SEPARATE ISSUES WEITHER OF WHICH CONSTITUTE A PRECONDITION FOR THE OTHER.
- 3. AS A CONCRETE PROOF OF ITS DESIRE AND INTENTION TO SPEEDILY TACKLE AND RESOLVE THE VAROSHA ISSUE, THE TURKISH CYPRIOT SIDE ACCEPTS IN PRINCIPLE TO PLACE THE SECTOR TO THE EAST OF DHERINIA ROAD AND EXTENDING IN THE SOUTH UP TO THE GREEK CYPRIOT FORWARD DEFENCE LINE OF THE VAROSHA AREA AS DEFINED IN THE TURKISH CYPRIOT MAP OF 5 AUGUST 1981, UNDER AN INTERIM UNITED NATIONS SUPERVISION AND ADMINISTRATION. THE MODALITIES AND CONDITIONS OF THIS TRANSFER SHALL BE DETERMINED BETHERN THE TURKISH CYPRIOT SIDE AND THE UNITED NATIONS.
- 4. THE INTERIM UNITED NATIONS SUPERVISION AND ADMINISTRATION TO BE ESTABLISHED IN THE SECTOR OF VAROSHA AS DEFINED ABOVE SHALL NOT PREJUDICE THE FINAL POLITICAL STATUS OF THE AREA AND IT SHALL CONTINUE UNTIL A FINAL COMPREHENSIVE POLITICAL SOLUTION OF THE CYPRUS PROBLEM.
- 5. THE QUESTION OF GREEK CYPRIOT RESETTLEMENT IN THE VAROSHA AREA AS BEFINED IN THE TURKISH CYPRIOT MAP OF 5 AUGUST 1981; SHALL RE CONSIDERED, AS STIPULATED IN POINT 5 OF THE 1979 DENKTAS-KYPRIANOU SUMMIT AGREEMENT, SIMULTANEOUSLY HITH THE BEGINNING OF NEGOTIATIONS FOR A COMPRENENSIVE SETTLEMENT; AND AFTER AGREEMENT HAS REEN REACHED ON THE RESETTLEMENT OF VAROSHA UNDER AN INTERIM UNITED NATIONS SUFERVISION AND ADMINISTRATION, SUCH AGREEMENT HILL BE IMPLEMENTED WITHOUT AMAITING THE OUTCOME OF THE DISCUSSIONS ON OTHER ASPECTS OF THE CYPRUS QUESTION.
- 6. THE OPENING OF THE AREA AS DEFINED IN THE TURKISH CYPRIOT MAP OF 5 AUGUST 1981 TO GREEK CYPRIOT RESETTLEMENT UNDER AN INTERIM UNITED NATIONS SUPERVISION AND ADMINISTRATION SHALL NOT PREJUDICE ITS FINAL POLITICAL STATUS.
- T. THE TURKISH CYPRIOT SIDE IS READY TO DISCUSS AND FINALIZE THE DETAILS OF THIS PROPOSAL WITH THE GREEK CYPRIOT SIDE AND WITH THE UNITED NATIONS.

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III. THE OPENING OF THE NICOSIA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT:

- 1. ON 17 NOVEMBER 1983 NE HAD PROPOSED THE RE-OFENING OF THE NICOSIA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT TO CIVILIAN TRAFFIC UNDER AN INTERIM U.N. ADMINISTRATION FOR THE MUTUAL BENEFIT OF THE THO SIDES IN CYPRUS.
- 2. IN THIS MAY, THE TURKISH CYPRIOT SIDE ACCEPTS HANDING OVER OF THE AIRPORT BY THE PARTIES, TO THE INTERIM U.N. ADMINISTRATION, MITHOUT INSISTING THAT THE RIRPORT BE ADMINISTERED BY THE PARTIES THEMSELVES, ON THE BASIS OF EQUALITY.
- 3. THE TURKISH CYPRIOT SIDE CONSIDERS THAT THE OPENING OF THE AIRPORT UNDER U.N. ABMINISTRATION HILL BE TO THE BENEFIT OF THE THO SIDES, AS A FACTOR CONTRIBUTING TOWARDS THE CREATION OF AN ATMOSPHERE OF GOODNILL AND MUTUAL TRUST.
- 4. THE TURKISH CYPRIOT SIDE IS READY TO DISCUSS AND FINALIZE THIS ISSUE WITH THE GREEK CYPRIOT SIDE, OR FAILING THIS, WITH THE U.N.
- 5. THE TURKISH CYPRIOT PROPOSAL CONCERNING THE AIRPORT DOES NOT CONSTITUTE A PRE-CONDITION FOR OTHER STEPS AIMED AT THE CREATION OF AN ATMOSPHERE OF GOODWILL IN CYPRUS.

IV. THE RE-ACTIVATION OF THE COMMITTEE ON MISSING PERSONS:

IN ORDER TO FINALIZE THE HUMANITARIAN ISSUE OF MISSING TURKISH AND GREEK CYPRICIS: HE PROPOSE THAT THE COMMITTEE ON MISSING PERSONS, SET UP IN 1981, BE RE-ACTIVATED, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FITERMS OF REFERENCETS AGREED TO BETWEEN THE THO SIDES; AND FOR THIS PURPOSE HE REQUEST THE THIRD MEMBER OF THE COMMITTEE, MR. PILLOUD, -THE ICRC REPRESENTATIVE - TO COME TO CYPRUS AT AN EARLY DATE. AS A MATTER OF FACT, LAST NOVEMBER, HE HAD BLREADY INFORMED MR. PILLOUD THAT THE COMMITTEE COULD BE RE-ACTIVATED INNEDIATELY, THAT THE TURKISH CYPRIOT SIDE WAS READY TO PARTI-CIPATE IN ITS DELIBERATIONS, AND THAT, THE PROCEDURAL OBSTACLES IMPEDING THE RE-ACTIVATION OF THE COMMITTEE HAD BEEN REMOVED BY THE CONCILIATORY PROPOSAL HE HAD MADE TO THE TURKISH CYPRIOT SIDE. NE BELIEVE THAT IT IS POSSIBLE FOR THE COMMITTEE TO MEET IN THE NEAR FUTURE TO INVESTIGATE AND FINALIZE THIS ISSUE OF MUTUAL CONCERN, WITHIN THE FRAMEWORK OF HUMANITARIAN CONSIDERATIONS. HE NOW INVITE THE GREEK CYPRIOT SIDE TO DECLARE ITS READINESS TO PARTICEPATE IN THESE DELIRERATIONS OF THE COMMITTEE.

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V. THE GENERAL FRAMEWORK OF THE RELATIONS BETHEEN THE THO SIDES FOR PROGRESS TOWARDS A FINAL SETTLEMENT:

IN ORDER TO CREATE AN ATMOSPHERE THAT HOULD HELP TOWARDS THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A LASTING PEACE IN THE ISLAND; HE BELIEVE THAT IT WOULD BE TO THE MUTUAL BENEFIT OF THE THO PEOPLES TO DEVELOP POINTS OF COMMON UNDERSTANDING BETHERN THE TURKISH CYPRIOTS AND GREEK CYPRIOTS, TO ENCOURAGE CONSTRUCTIVE MODES OF ATTITUDE AND, TO THIS ENB, TO CREATE CERTAIN AREAS OF CO-OPERATION. I HISH TO ANNOUNCE, IN DETAIL, TO WORLD PUBLIC OPINION: OUR PROPOSALS AND THOUGHTS ON THIS SUBJECT, HITH THE HOPE THAT THEY HOULD BE STUDIED WITH GOODHILL BY THE GREEK CYPRIOT SIDE AND RECIPROCATED IN A POSITIVE MANNER.

I WISH TO EMPHASIZE THAT THIS APPROACH, WHICH I WILL SET OUT HERE AND WHICH TAKES INTO ACCOUNT THE SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS OF CYPRUS, HAS BEEN USEFULLY APPLIED IN OTHER PARTS OF THE HORLD AS A MODEL FOR RESOLVING DISPUTES FAR MORE COMPLICATED THAN THE ONES IN CYPRUS, AND TO REITERATE OUR CONVICTION THAT THIS APPROACH COULD PLAY A CONSTRUCTIVE ROLE IN THE SOLUTION OF OUR OWN PROBLEM.

HE HAVE ALREADY DECLARED OUR FIRM BELIEF THAT THE TURKISH CYPRIOTS AND THE GREEK CYPRIOTS, WHO ARE DESTINED TO CO-EXIST SIDE BY SIDE IN THE ISLAND, CAN AND MUST FIND PEACEFUL, JUST AND DURABLE SOLUTIONS TO ALL THE DIFFERENCES BETHEEN THEM, THROUGH DIRECT NEGOTIATIONS.

THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A HORKING PARTNERSHIP MITHIN A FEDERAL FRAMEWORK CONTINUES TO BE OUR AIM AND HE ARE DETERMINED TO MAKE EVERY CONSTRUCTIVE EFFORT TO THIS END.

ON THE OTHER HAND, WE HAVE URGED THE GREEK CYPRIOT SIDE TO ADOPT AN APPROACH HAICH HOULD FACILITATE THE IMMEDIATE TAKING OF MERSURES OF GOODNILL ON MATTERS THAT CAN BE RESOLVED IN THE SHORT TERM, NITH THE OBJECT OF NARROWING THE GAP BETHEEN THE THO PEOPLES IN CYPRUS.

IN KEEPING WITH THESE OBJECTIVES: I WISH TO PROPOSE THAT THE THO SIDES REACH A COMMON UNDERSTANDING ALONG THE FOLLOWING LINES; IN ORDER TO PROMOTE AN ATMOSPHERE OF GOODWILL; ESTABLISH MUTUAL CONFIDENCE AND THUS FACILITATE PROGRESS TOWARDS A FINAL COMPREHENSIVE SOLUTION OF OUR PROBLEMS AND HITHOUT ANY PREJUDICE TO THEIR RESPECTIVE POSITIONS WITH REGARD TO EACH OTHER!S FOLITICAL STATUS;

I, THE TURKISH CYPRIOT SIDE AND THE GREEK CYPRIOT SIDE ARE RESOLVED TO PREVENT THE RECURRENCE OF THE SUFFERINGS OF THE PAST AND TO NORK FOR RECONCILIATION AND COMPROMISE BETHEEN THE THO PEOPLES OF THE ISLAND AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A DURABLE PEACE SO THAT BOTH SIDES MAY DEVOTE THEIR ENERGIES TO THE PRESSING TASK OF CREATING A FEDERAL UNION AND ENHANCING THEIR SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.

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IN ORDER TO ACHIEVE THIS OBJECTIVE, THE TURKISH CYPRIOT SIDE AND THE GREEK CYPRIOT SIDE REAFFIRM THEIR UNDERSTANDING OF THE FOLLOWING COMMON GROUND ON WHICH THEIR ACTIONS SHALL BE BASED:

- (I) THE BASIC ISSUES AND CAUSES OF CONFLICT WHICH HAVE BEDEVILLED THE RELATIONS BETHEEN THE THO PEOPLES IN THE ISLAND FOR THE PAST 20 YEARS SHALL BE RESOLVED THROUGH PEACEFUL MEANS BY THE THO SIDES. IN ORDER TO SETTLE THEIR DIFFERENCES BY PEACEFUL MEANS THE THO SIDES UNDERTAKE TO MAKE EVERY EFFORT UNDER THE AUSPICES OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE UNITED NATIONS AND TO SUPPORT HIS HISSION OF GOOD OFFICES.
- (11) THE COMMITMENT BY BOTH SIDES TO PERCEFUL CO-EXISTENCE, RESPECT FOR EACH OTHER'S POLITICAL EQUALITY, LEGI-TIMATE RIGHTS AND INTERESTS, AND THE PURSUIT OF NEGOTIATIONS FOR A FEDERAL SOLUTION ARE THE PRE-REQUISITES FOR RECONCILIATION BETHEEN THEM AND FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A DURABLE PEACE IN THE ISLAND.
- (III) BOTH PARTIES REAFFIRMED THEIR SUPPORT FOR THE COMMON GROUND AS OUTLINED IN THE U.N. SECRETARY-GENERAL'S OPENING STATEMENT OF 9 AUGUST 1980.
- (IV) THEY SHALL ALWAYS RESPECT EACH OTHER'S NATIONAL IDENTITY AS REFLECTED BY THE DIFFERENT LANGUAGE; RELIGION, CULTURE AND ORIGIN OF THE THO PEOPLES OF THE ISLAND; AND SHALL STRIVE TO ESTABLISH A BI-ZONAL FEDERATION RASED ON THE PARTNERSHIP AND COOPERATION OF THESE THO PEOPLES.
- 2. BOTH SIDES WILL TAKE ALL STEPS WITHIN THEIR POWER TO PREVENT HOSTILE PROPAGANDA DIRECTED AGAINST EACH OTHER AND SHALL ENCOURAGE THE DISSEMINATION OF SUCH INFORMATION AS HOULD CONTRIBUTE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF MUTUAL CONFIDENCE.
- 3. IN ORDER PROGRESSIVELY TO RESTORE AND HARMONIZE THE RELATIONS BETWEEN THEM STEP BY STEP:
- (I) THE THO SIDES SHALL GIVE PRIORITY TO REACHING AN AGREEMENT ON THE RESETTLEMENT OF VAROSHA UNDER AN INTERIM UNITED NATIONS SUPERVISION AND ADMINISTRATION AS ENVISAGED IN PARAGRAPH 5 OF THE TEN-POINT AGREEMENT OF 19 MAY 1979; TAKING INTO ACCOUNT THE TURKISH CYPRIOT PROPOSAL ALREADY MADE ON THIS ISSUE.
- CII) THE THO SIDES SHALL CO-OPERATE FOR THE REOPENING OF THE NICOSIA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT FOR CIVILIAN TRAFFIC UNDER AN INTERIM UNITED NATIONS ADMINISTRATION TO THE MUTUAL BENEFIT OF THE THO SIDES IN CYPRUS.
- (III) THE THO SIDES SHALL RESOLVE THE HUMANITARIAN QUESTION OF THE TURKISH CYPRIOT AND GREEK CYPRIOT MISSING PERSONS HITHIN THE COMMITTEE ON MISSING PERSONS IN CYPRUS (CHP) ESTABLISHED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE AGREED TERMS OF REFERENCE IN 1981.

(IV) THE THO SIDES SHALL REFRAIN FROM HAMPERING EACH OTHER'S INTERESTS IN THE FIELDS OF TRADE; TOURISH, TRANSPORTATIONS, COMMUNICATION; ETC., IN ORDER TO PROMOTE GOODHILL AND MUTUAL CONFIDENCE AND FOR THEIR OVERALL BENEFIT AND PROSPERITY.

(V) THE TWO SIDES SHALL BENEFIT EQUITABLY FROM ALL ECONOMIC, FINANCIAL AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE PROVIDED FOR CYPRUS. THEY HILL ESTABLISH: A JOINT BODY AT TECHNICAL LEVEL IN ORDER TO SHARE EQUITABLY SUCH INTERNATIONAL AID. THEY SHALL NOT INTERFERE HITH THE EXTENSION OF CREDIT OR OTHER FINANCIAL FACILITIES TO EITHER OF THE THO SIDES BY INTERNATIONAL LENDING INSTITUTIONS.

CVI) AN ECONOMIC AND TECHNICAL COMMISSION SHALL BE SET UP TO STUDY THE QUESTION OF COOPERATION BETHEEN THE THO SIDES IN THE FOLLOWING AREAS:

- TRADE,
- TOURISM AND TRAVEL:
- MUNICIPAL PROBLEMS,
- NATER SUPPLY: NATER PRESERVATION AND SOIL CONSERVATION:
- ENVIRONMENTAL PROBLEMS.

(VII) A JOINT HEALTH COMMISSION SHALL BE SET UP TO COORDINATE EFFORTS ON BOTH SIDES FOR DEALING NITH EPIDEMICS.

(VIII) THE THO SIBES SHALL CONSIDER THE FOLLOHING JOINT ENDEAVOURS IN THE CULTURAL FIELD TO PROMOTE A BETTER UNDERSTANDING BETNEEN THE YOUNGER GENERATIONS: IN PARTICULAR:

- TO PROMOTE THE TEACHING OF TURKISH AND GREEK AS SECOND LANGUAGE RESPECTIVELY:
- TO COOPERATE IN HIGHER EDUCATION AND TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF SETTING UP A JOINT UNIVERSITY THAT HILL SERVE STUDENTS FROM BOTH SIDES, TAKING INTO ACCOUNT THE DIVERSE CULTURAL HERITAGES AND IDENTITIES OF THE THO PEOPLES IN THE ISLAND,
- TO ORGANIZE JOINT CULTURAL AND SPORTIVE ACTIVITIES (SPORTS COMPETITIONS, EXHIBITIONS, CONCERTS, SEMINARS),
- TO ORGANIZE SCIENTIFIC AND CULTURAL JOINT MEETINGS TO DISCUSS PROBLEMS COMMON TO THE ISLAND (THALESSEMIA, ETC.3)
- TO ORGANIZE A SEMINAR ON FEDERALISM IN GENERAL; AND ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE FEDERAL PRINCIPLES IN THE CONTEXT OF CYPRUS; HITH THE PARTICIPATION OF SELECTED LAHYERS AND FOLITICAL SCIENTISTS.

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- 4. BOTH SIDES AGREE THAT THEY SHALL REFRAIN FROM ALL KINDS OF PROVOCATIONS AND FURTHER UNDERTAKE TO REFRAIN FROM THE THREAT OR THE USE OF FORCE.
- 5. BOTH SIDES AGREE THAT THEIR RESPECTIVE LEADERS WILL MEET UNDER THE AUSPICES OF THE UNITED NATIONS SECRETARY-GENERAL TO DISCUSS THE PROCESS OF STEADILY HOVING TOWARDS A FEDERAL ARRANGEMENT AND TO GIVE GUIDANCE TO THEIR REPRESENTATIVES WHO WILL ENTER INTO NEGOTIATIONS ON THE MODALITIES AND ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DURABLE PERCE THROUGH A FINAL FEDERAL SETTLEMENT.
- 6. BOTH SIDES AGREE TO CALL UPON TURKEY AND GREECE TO ENCOURAGE AND ASSIST THEIR EFFORTS IN THE SEARCH FOR A NEGOTIATED SETTLEMENT ON THE BASIS OF THE 1977 DENKTAS-MAKARIOS AGREEMENT, THE 1979 DENKTAS-KYPRIANOU AGREEMENT, THE 1980 PROPENING STATEMENT? OF THE U.N. SECRETARY-GENERAL AND THE 1981 U.N. PEVALUATION DOCUMENT?
