At the 30th and 31st meetings, on 29 October, the Committee engaged in a question-and-answer session with the Special Rapporteur, in which the following delegations took part: Netherlands, Republic of Korea, Guatemala, New Zealand, Canada, Iran (Islamic Republic of), Democratic Republic of the Congo, Estonia, Indonesia and Syrian Arab Republic (see A/C.3/59/SR.30 and 31).

Also at the 31st meeting, the Special Rapporteur on trafficking in persons, especially in women and children, addressed the Committee and engaged in a question-and-answer session with the following delegations: United States of America, Thailand, Japan, Netherlands (on behalf of the States Members of the United Nations that are members of the European Union), Philippines, Burkina Faso and India (see A/C.3/59/SR.31).
