Article 4 (1)

CANADA, KENYA, UNION OF SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLICS, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA and DENMARK

"Adoption by States of temporary special measures aimed at accelerating <u>de facto</u> equality of women with men shall not be considered discrimination as defined in this Convention, but shall in no way entail, as a consequence, the maintenance of unequal or separate standards and shall be discontinued when the objectives of equality of opportunity and treatment have been achieved."

Article 5

MALI, SYRIAN ARAB REPUBLIC, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA and the UNION OF SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLICS

"The States Parties shall take all appropriate measures

- (a) to modify ... (as adopted).
- (b) to ensure that family education includes a proper understanding of maternity as a social function and the recognition of the common responsibility of both men and women in the upbringing and development of their children."
