Article 22 (revised)

- The States Parties undertake to submit, at least every four years, reports on the implementation of the present convention to the Secretary-General of the United Stations.
- Reports may indicate factors and difficulties affecting the degree of fulfilment of obligations under the present Convention.
- Where relevant information has previously been furnished to the United Nations or to any specialized agency, it will not be necessary for any State Party to reproduce that information, but a precise reference will suffice.
- The first such report would be cutmitted within one year after the entry into force for the State concerned.
