23 (5) A STATE PARTY WHICH HAS SUBMITTED A COMPREHENSIVE INITIAL REPORT TO THE COMMITTEE NEED NOT IN ITS SUBSEQUENT REPORTS SUBMITTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH 1 (b), REPEAT BASIC INFORMATION PREVIOUSLY PROVIDED AND MAY CONCENTRATE ON THOSE CHANGES (INCLUDING LEGAL, ADMINISTRATIVE AND IN PRACTICE), THAT RELATE TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CONVENTION IN THAT STATE, AS WELL AS RESPONDING TO ANY QUESTIONS THE COMMITTEE MAY HAVE RAISED WHEN CONSIDERING PREVIOUS REPORTS FROM THAT STATE PARTY.
