(a) DRAFT CONVENTION ON TORTURE AND OTHER CRUEL, INHUMAN OR DEGRADING TREATMENT OR PUNISHMENT

Sweden: draft resolution

Working group to prepare a Convention against Torture The Commission on Human Rights,

<u>Having in mind</u> General Assembly resolution 32/62 by which the Commission was requested to draw up a draft convention on torture and other cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment, and General Assembly resolution 33/178 by which the Commission was requested, at its thirty-fifth session, to give high priority to the question of drafting such a convention,

Recalling that such a draft convention has been discussed in a working group during the thirty-fifth session of the Commission but that it was not found possible to complete the work during that session,

<u>Desirous</u> to make arrangements to expedite the work on the draft convention with a view to its early adoption,

- 1. Recognizes that it is advisable to continue the work on the draft convention in a working group which should meet before the thirty-sixth session of the Commission,
- 2. <u>Decides</u> to accord high priority to the consideration of this question at its thirty-sixth session.
- 3. Recommends that the Economic and Social Council should adopt the following resolution:

"The Economic and Social Council,

Recalling General Assembly resolution 32/62 by which the Commission on Human Rights was requested to draw up a draft convention on torture and other cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment, or punishment, and General Assembly resolution 33/178 by which the Commission was requested, at its thirty-fifth session, to give high priority to the question of drafting such a convention, Considering that it was not found possible to complete the work on the convention during the thirty-fifth session of the Commission,

Taking note of the Commission on Human Rights resolution .../XXXV,

- 1. <u>Authorizes</u> a meeting of an open-ended working group for a period of three weeks prior to the thirty-sixth session of the Commission on Human Rights to complete the work on a draft convention against torture.
- 2. Requests the Secretary-General to transmit to the Commission on Human Rights at its thirty-sixth session all relevant materials relating to the draft convention."
