

Statement submitted by the Secretary-General in accordance with rule 28 of the rules of procedure of the functional commissions of the Economic and Social Council

Under the terms of operative paragraph 2 of draft resolution E/CN.4/L.1466, the Commission would authorize the Sub-Commission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities to request Mrs. Questiaux to continue the study on the implication for human rights of states of siege and emergency.
