ORDER EXTENDING TEMPORARY INJUNCTION

This cause came on this day to be heard upon the temporary injunction order entered on June 6, 2017; upon the motion of Plaintiffs requesting an extension of said order, and adding the statue of Thomas J. "Stonewall" Jackson to its protection per ruling of this Court on October 4, 2017; and upon the representation of counsel that the parties have agreed to the entry of this Order which extends the temporary injunction.

Upon consideration whereof and for reasons sufficient to the Court, the Court doth
ADJUDGE, ORDER and DECREE as follows:

1. That the temporary injunction order entered on June 6, 2017 be, and hereby is extended, until entry by this Court of a final order in this case.
2. That the provisions of the June 6, 2017 order shall apply, *mutatis mutandis*, to the Thomas J. "Stonewall" Jackson statue located in Jackson Park, now called Justice Park.





** Defendants note that the Court has been made aware that the Charlottesville City Council, within adopted resolutions, has stated its intention that no action will be taken to remove either the Lee statue or the Jackson statue until a favorable court ruling is rendered in favor of the Plaintiffs in this action, therefore the agreement to extend the existing injunction order is made as an affirmation of Council's intentions. Defendants note their continuing objections to the Court's expansion of the Temporary Injunction Order entered June 6, 2017 to include the Jackson statue in Justice Park; Defendants reaffirm their objections to the Temporary Injunction Order entered June 6, 2017 and to this Court's new Order expanding that injunction and further, Defendants continue to object to the Court's ruling in its October 3, 2017 opinion letter that §15.2-1812 and §15.2-1812.1 are subject to retroactive application.
