Draft Convention on the Elimination of Discrimination  
against Women

Texts adopted by the Working Group on the Draft Convention  
on the Elimination of Discrimination against Women at its  
9th meeting held on 17 November 1977

Article 7

Adopted as amended by Argentina, the text reads as follows:

"The States Parties shall take all appropriate measures, including  
legislation to suppress all forms of traffic in women and exploitation of  
prostitution of women."

Article 8

Introductory phrase was adopted as amended by the United Kingdom and  
subamended by Australia and the USSR. The text will appear in  
A/C.3/32/WG.1/CRP.7/Add.7.

Paragraph (a): Adopted as amended by the Syrian Arab Republic and Denmark.  
The text reads as follows:

"To vote in all elections and public referenda and to be eligible for election  
to all publicly elected bodies."

Paragraph (b): Decision was postponed.

Paragraph (c): Deleted.

Paragraph (d): Adopted by consensus, the text reads as follows:

"To participate in non-governmental organizations and associations concerned with the public and political life of the country."

Article 9: Decision was postponed.

Article 10: Decision was postponed.
