Proposal submitted by Poland

Article 22 (revised)

1. The States Parties undertake to submit, at least every four years, reports on the implementation of the present convention to the Secretary-General of the United Nations.
2. Reports may indicate factors and difficulties affecting the degree of fulfilment of obligations under the present Convention.
3. Where relevant information has previously been furnished to the United Nations or to any specialized agency, it will not be necessary for any State Party to reproduce that information, but a precise reference will suffice.
4. The first such report would be submitted within one year after the entry into force for the State concerned.
